You are invited to participate in the 17th Annual Donkey Creek Festival (DCF) in historic downtown Gillette, Wyoming on June 22, 2024. This one day festival is back and will showcase Wyoming's talented musicians, artists, and craftspeople.

The DCF Committee is a non-profit charitable organization, and all proceeds are used to produce the festival.

ARTISAN VILLAGE INFORMATION

There is **NO FEE** this year to share your arts and crafts, your talents, or to represent a local arts organization. Our goal is to make this festival a place where the arts are free for all. We are generously supported by public funds that will allow us to keep our Artisan Village free this year. There are 45 booth spaces available on a first come, first served basis.

No commission on artist sales will be retained by the Festival. Examples of acceptable artist submissions include: pottery, painting, original photography, and handmade art mediums which must be original and made by the exhibitor. Other examples of acceptable submissions include: handmade soap, locally grown flower arrangements, locally made honey, olive oil, or spice blends, home-baked foods or cottage foods, and hand-crafted jewelry. **No food vending is allowed. No multi-level marketing (Scentsy, Tupperware) is allowed. All items must be handcrafted.** Local arts organizations are also invited to attend to share the great work you do in our community. This is a juried event and all participants will be approved by the event committee. Include at least two images of your work and one image of your booth with this application. If a booth image is not available, please provide a description/materials and diagram. Printed photos, or digital images are acceptable. All spaces are approximately 10' wide by 10' deep. All tents, tables, and anything else required is the responsibility of the vendors. Electricity is not provided for booths in the Artisan Village. The festival takes place at Big Lost Meadery and the Artisan Village is in the parking lot behind Two Guys Deco. Tents will need weights or stands rather than stakes. Booth locations may not be perfectly level.

GENERATORS ARE NOT PERMITTED.

WEATHER:

Wyoming is known for unpredictable and inclement weather. Vendors should be prepared for any weather changes. If the weather becomes severe, a Festival coordinator will consider and determine suspension, cancellation or relocation of part or all of event.

TAXES, ETC:

All participating artists are required to collect and pay the appropriate local and state sales tax. For the sales tax rate in Campbell County, please check with the Department of Revenue: http:// revenue.state.wy.us/

SECURITY:

No security personnel will be provided. Vendors are encouraged to secure their booths/belongings.

FEES:

There are NO FEES to participate in the Artisan Village at the Donkey Creek Music and Arts Festival. The festival is supported in part by the Wyoming Arts Council, which receives support from the State of Wyoming and the National Endowment for the Arts; the Wyoming Cultural Trust Fund, a program of the Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources; and the Campbell County Community Public Recreation District.
